Hi Lost Mountain Parents and Students

On Thursday, the governor announced that those who are 65 years and older are no longer required to shelter in place, effective immediately, unless they are living in longterm care facilities or if they are medically fragile

Anyone who otherwise is medically compromised - including those who have chronic diseases or underlying health conditions is still being asked to stay at home. The order, titled "Empowering a Healthy Georgia," goes into effect at 12 a.m. Tuesday, June 16 and lasts until 11:59 p.m. June 30.

As part of the same executive order, Kemp allowed even more leeway for public gatherings - from movie theaters to live entertainment venues.
